THE CONSTITUTION OF THE ISLAND OF MAS A TIERRA

1675

BY THE GRACE OF GOD AND CHARLES II KING OF ENGLAND, SCOTLAND, FRANCE AND IRELAND, DEFENDER OF THE FAITH. I, ROBINSON CRUSOE, AS GOVERNOR OF THE ISLAND, DO ORDAIN AND ESTABLISH THIS CONSTITUTION:

ARTICLE 1

THE LEGISLATIVE, EXECUTIVE AND JURIDICAL POWERS SHALL BE VESTED IN THE GOVERNOR, HE SHALL HOLD HIS OFFICE FOR LIFE.

ARTICLE 2

IN CASE OF GOVERNOR'S DEATH OR INABILITY TO DISCHARGE HIS POWER, NO PERSON EXCEPT A BRITISH-BORN CITIZEN SHALL BE NOMINABLE TO THE OFFICE.

ARTICLE 3

THE ISLAND SHALL BE POLITICALLY INDEPENDENT FROM THE MOTHERLAND BUT IT SHALL PROMOTE AND PROTECT THE VALUES OF THE UNITED KINGDOM.

ARTICLE 4

BRITISH AND EUROPEAN CITIZENS SHALL BE ENTITLED TO ALL RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF THEIR CONDITION. INSTEAD ALL NATIVES SHALL BE ENSLAVED AND FULFIL ALL THE TASKS REQUIRED TO ENSURE THE SOCIETY'S GROWTH.

ARTICLE 5

ANGLICANISM SHALL BE REGARDED THE ONLY RELIGION ALLOWED. IN ORDER TO REPRESS AND EXTIRPATE ALL HERESIES AND ABUSES THE KING SHALL BE REPUTED THE ONLY SUPREME HEAD IN EARTH OF THE CHURCH OF ENGLAND AND HIS REPRESENTATIVE ON THE ISLAND SHALL BE THE GOVERNOR,

ARTICLE 6


ALL NATIVES SHALL HAVE TO REPUDIATE THEIR PAGAN AND PRIMITIVE PRACTICES SUCH AS CANNIBALISM, CONVERT TO THE ONE TRUE FAITH AND LEARN ENGLISH LANGUAGE.

ARTICLE 7

ECONOMIC INITIATIVE, PRIVATE PROPERTY, TRADES
AND DISCOVERIES ARE SUPPORTED BY THE
INSTITUTIONS. ALL CITIZENS HAVE THE RIGHT TO
HAVE SLAVE, EVERYBODY SHALL HAVE TO
CONTRIBUTE TO BUILD A STRONG AND PROSPEROUS
SOCIETY.

ARTICLE 8

NATURE, AS GOD'S CREATION, IS PROTECTED, IT CAN BE SHAPED TO IMPROVE LIVING CONDITIONS BUT IT DESERVES RESPECT. MOREOVER ANIMALS ARE AN INTEGRAL PART OF SOCIETY.



ARTICLE 9 THE RIGHT OF CITIZENS TO KEEP ARMS SHALL NOT BE INFRINGED, NATIVE POSSESSION OF WEAPONS SHALL NOT BE TOLERATED EXCEPT IN WARFARE. ANY KIND OF BETRAYAL OF INSTITUTIONS SHALL BE PUNISHED BY DEATH. ARTICLE 10 CONSTITUTIONAL ARTICLES SHALL BE ADDED OR AMENDED ONLY BY DECISION OF THE GOVERNOR, Robinson Chusol Charles B BELOTTI L'I
